



## BEQUEST OPTIONS

If you wish to remember Selfhelp through a bequest in your will, we would appreciate you or your attorney notifying us, so that we may include you in our Living Legacy Society.

If you do decide to remember Selfhelp in your estate plan, your attorney will need our full legal title and address contained in the sample language below. Please note that while Selfhelp will provide whatever assistance we can, we cannot provide legal or professional advice. It is advisable to consult with your attorney or estate planner to ensure that your will is legally valid.

### *General Bequest*
